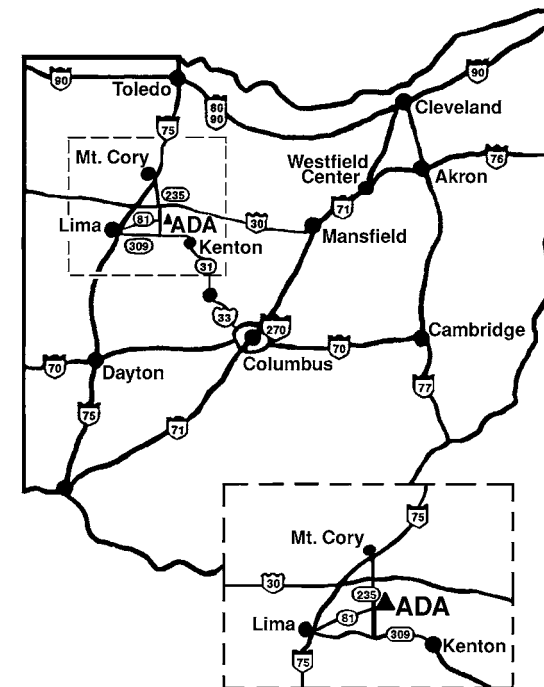
Victor Streib is a professor of law and former law dean at Ohio Northern University who has taught criminal law and ethics to over 5,000 students at ten institutions since 1971. His scholarly research has generated over 300 books, chapters, articles and papers, resulting in his recognition as "the most prolific scholar in the history of ONU." The U.S. Supreme Court has cited Streib's work 28 times in 7 cases over the past two decades. Concerned about law in action as well as theory, Streib has defended clients in murder cases before many courts, including the U.S. Supreme Court. He also consults and testifies as an expert witness nationally.
