Are We Wireless Yet?

The installation of the ONU wireless network is nearly complete. So, if you have a laptop with wireless capability, you can access the network from anywhere in the building. Steps for proper configuration will be handed out during orientation and available in the main lab.

Do I Have The MBlaster Worm? If you use Windows XP or 2000, surf the net, and have not installed the Microsoft patch, then you might have the 'worm'. Download and run Fixblast.exe from the S:\scratch drive. When prompted to go to the URL to install the patch, click NO. Instead copy and install the appropriate patch from the S:\scratch drive. There are separate patches for XP and 2000. If you need help, see Larry.



Free Software? -- In the next few days the circulation desks at the Taggart Law Library and Heterick Memorial Library (ONU's main campus library) will have available for loan Microsoft Windows XP Pro and Microsoft Office XP. A license has been purchased so that every student is able to install these programs legally and without charge. The software will also be made available on the website for download. In the coming months it will be necessary for all students to have Windows XP in order to be allowed to access the network. Watch the library message boards for availability.

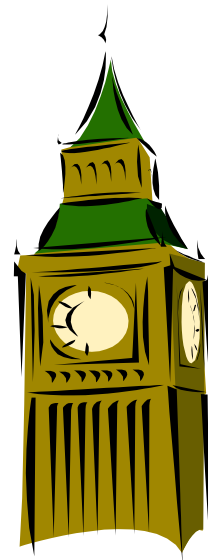

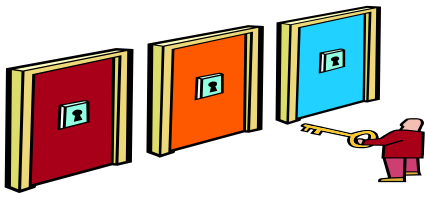
