



LEGAL RESEARCH MINI-WORKSHOPS BEGIN SEPTEMBER 15

On Monday, September 15, 2003, the Taggart Law Library will begin holding its annual legal research mini-workshops. The workshops are intended to help first-year law students learn more about how to find and use law library materials. The workshops are about 30 minutes in length and will be held over the next seven weeks.

Each week the workshop will focus on a different legal research activity. For example, workshops held during the first week will focus on finding and updating case law. Workshop topics will co-ordinate with topics being covered in the first year Legal Research and Writing program.

Mini-workshops will be held in the Supreme Court Alcove next to the Reading Room on the south side of the Law Library. Sign-up sheets will be available on the table in the central hallway of the Law Library.

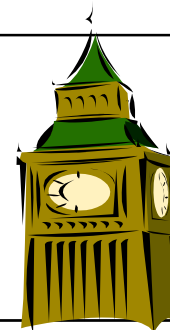


LAW LIBRARY REFERENCE DESK INFORMATION

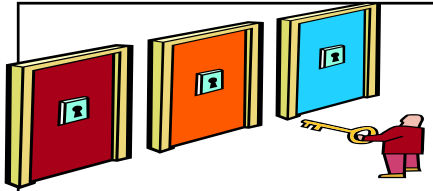
