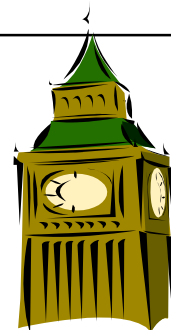


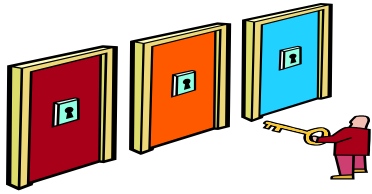

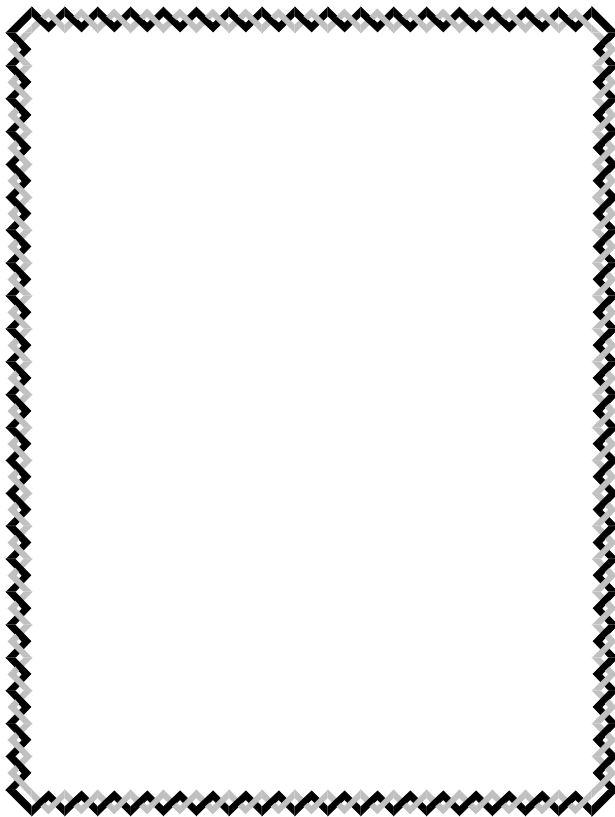
WINDOWS XP PROFESSIONAL MICROSOFT OFFICE XP PROFESSIONAL

Still Available!

Law students can still obtain a free copy of Windows XP Pro and Office XP. Both applications are available in the tech support office next to the lab in the law library.

XP Pro allows you to sign on to the school's network and access the drives that are available to you — such as the scratch drive, where all the virus fixes are located, and your personal H:drive. It also allows you to install network printers so that you can print to any printer on the school's network.

Office XP is a suite of Microsoft programs that includes Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Outlook, and Access.



DID YOU KNOW?



- 1) When Norton finds a virus, many times it "quarantines" the virus so that it can't affect other files. You can delete these quarantined files by opening the Norton Antivirus program (Start\Programs), double-clicking View and then selecting Quarantine. Next select the listed files and click on the red X at the top of the window.
- 2) The two computers in the main lab with attached printers now have the full version of Adobe Acrobat. You can now edit Adobe PDF files before printing them.
