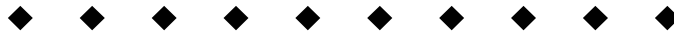
Carrels To Be Cleaned During Winter Break

Windows Service Pack 2 Update



If you haven't already done so, you should install the Windows Service Pack 2 Update on your computer before the start of the spring semester. This update will provide greater security against Trojan horses and viruses that could affect your computer.

Be sure to back up any important documents you don't want to lose **before** attempting to install Service Pack 2.

You can download and install Service Pack 2 by using Windows Update (www.windowsupdate.com) or by obtaining a disk available in Larry Baumgardner's office. The update will take about an hour to complete.
