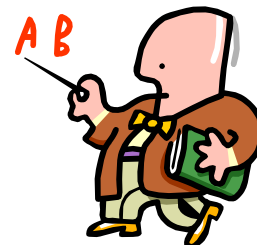

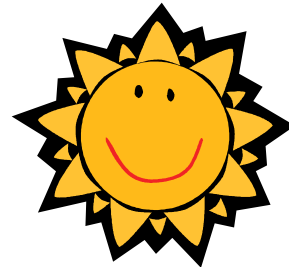
Do you have a carrel card?

Need to clean out your carrel?

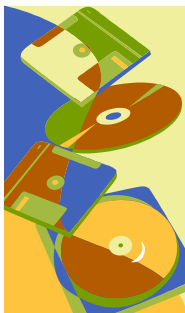
Please remember to return library books and carrel cards before you leave for the summer. Carrel cards and books should be returned to the circulation desk by **12 noon on Friday, May 13th.**
