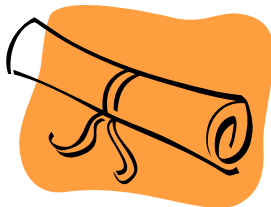

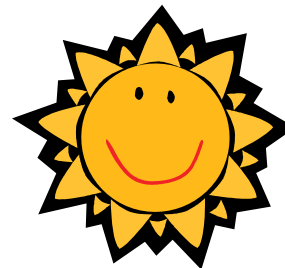

Do you have books checked out?

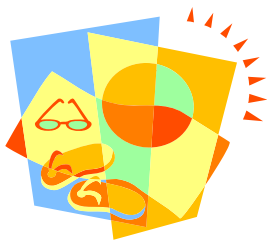
Do you have a carrel card?
