## Library Construction Update

The Hanson Reading Room project is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 12th, the day after graduation. The construction will be done by Thomas & Marker Construction, who have worked on other campus buildings including the Freed Center and King-Horn Sports Center. The architectural firm that designed the new space is Miller Lecky Architects from Columbus. Here are the latest construction updates:

- Construction on the new technology center has been completed. Larry and his assistants have moved their work area into this new space, and computers and other equipment have also started moving. The technology center will be ready for use next week, and it will be open for use throughout the summer.
- When the reading room construction begins, it will be necessary to close the south side of the library because of noise and safety concerns. Books on this side of the library can still be retrieved for your use by library staff. The north side of the library will remain open.
- Books are still being moved from the Reference and Reading Rooms to other locations in the library. If you need help finding books that have moved, please ask a member of the library staff to assist you.
- Several library staff members will be moving for the summer to temporary offices in the following locations (please note that phone numbers and e-mail addresses will stay the same):

When construction is completed in August, these staff members will have office space in the old computer lab, and two new study rooms will be available in the current library office space.

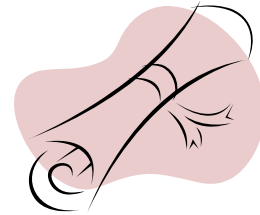

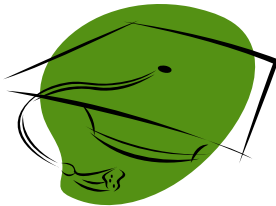
