Construction Update and Summer Library Services

Construction on the new Hanson Reading Room is underway! Starting the day after graduation, physical plant and law library staff worked together to prepare the reading room for the contractors, Thomas & Marker Construction. (See the before and after pictures below)



The construction crew has begun work and has set up a temporary wall to isolate the construction area and protect books on the south side of the library.

This construction project will change library services this summer in several ways:

- The south side of the library will be closed during the summer. If you need any materials for study or research from the south side, please request them at the circulation desk and a member of the library staff will retrieve them for you.
- The new technology center is now up and running and will be accessible all summer. The old computer lab is now empty and is part of the construction area.
- Several library staff members' offices have moved for the summer. If you need research assistance, David Fetrow is in the new microforms room near the Law Review office and Elizabeth Christian is in Room #161 at the end of the windows on the north side of the library. 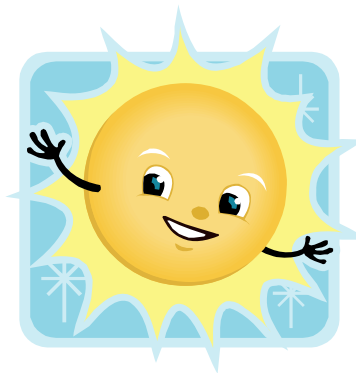
